

HELPFUL HINTS

WHERE TO PLACE LABELS



For best results, place the label on the tag of the garment! If the tag is large enough to fit a "small all purpose" label, those may be used on garments as well. However, it is crucial that the label fits completely onto the garment tag and that there are no edges hanging over! If you have a "tagless" garment, we recommend placing the label on the washing instruction tag, which is usually located on the inside side seam. If your garment doesn't have any tags anywhere.... you can place the label directly onto the garment, however, due to the many different types of fabric, we can't guarantee the durability.

HOW TO APPLY OUR LABELS



When you apply the label to the garment tag, make sure to use pressure! Press down

with your thumb, then press between your thumb and index finger... basically crushing the label into the tag! You'll know you've done it right when you can almost see the texture of the garment tag in the label itself! It is VERY IMPORTANT that all four corners of the label are stuck down.... You do not want water to be able to get underneath the label and ruin the adhesive!

For "high-contact" areas, we suggest our exclusive laminated option for an extra layer of protection. Super thin and a must for labels heading to camp!

WASHING OUR LABELS



washing clothing that you have applied our

labels to. No exceptions. Our labels are adhesive backed and need time to bond to the garment tag. If washed before they have had enough time to bond, the labels may fall off. Please follow these instructions!

important details

If your labels are going to be in contact with harsh chemicals such as chlorine, sunscreen, cleaning agents or extreme heat, we HIGHLY recommend our laminated option. Laminate is a thin extra layer of protection that is applied during the production process. Laminating gives the labels that extra layer of protection needed for those high-contact areas.

LABEL DADDY LABELS ARE NOT TOYS AND SHOULD ONLY BE APPLIED BY AN ADULT. DO NOT IRON LABELS!

zipper tag info

Zipper tags are for tagging / labeling your garment, they are not intended to be used as a pull!! Pulling and tugging on the zipper tag instead of actual garment zipper may result in broken or lost tag.

Big "NO-NO'S"!



NO NO'S: Do not apply clothing labels to garments that have been pre-treated with

a stain/water repellent, such as scotch-guard! They won't stick to a "non-stick" surface! Cold weather gear is a good example of garments that may contain a repellent. Labels should be applied to the inside tags of these types of items. Do not apply labels to fabric with heavy ribbing or texture such as lace or swim suits. Do not iron labels!
